CT SCAN OF THE BRAIN PLAIN:

A non infused axial CT scan of the brain from the skull base to the vertex showed normal gray/white matter differentiation. Normal size and shape of the ventricles for patient's age. There is no evidence of edema, mass or mass effect. No intracranial bleeding noted. The paranasal sinuses and the mastoid cells appear well aerated. No radiological evidence of skull base fracture.
