
The Case of the Double Mothers

The same physical Adi Shakti on Earth also had to consult Her own self within Her own Sahasrara if She wanted to know anything, just like Kash.

☐ The Spirit Adi Shakti in the Sahasrara had infinite awareness at all times whereas the physical Adi Shakti did not. The Toronto public program soundly proved this fact when Kash tried to hand over the Rock of Shri Ganesha to Her.
