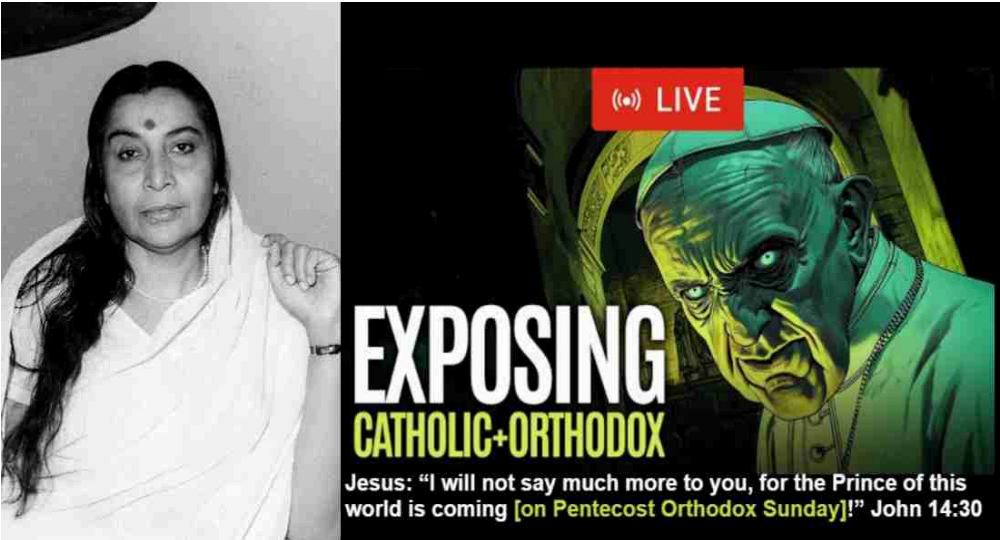

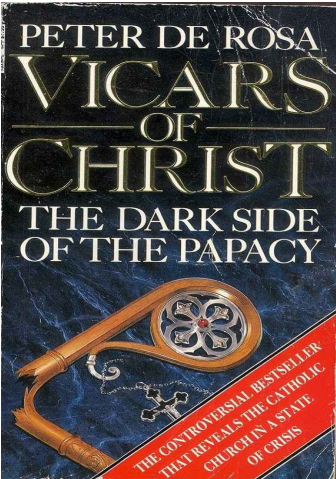

The Context of Spiritual Darkness: John 12:35

In John 12:35, Jesus provides additional context that directly connects the Prince's arrival with the onset of spiritual darkness: "Then Jesus told them, 'You are going to have the light just a little while longer.
