'In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people.' Explain how being born of the Spirit of John 3:4-5 is related to God pouring his Spirit on all people of Acts 2:17.

The conversation between Jesus and Nicodemus in John 3:4-5 reveals the necessity of being born of the Spirit to enter the kingdom of God. Nicodemus, a Pharisee and a teacher of Israel, was puzzled by Jesus's words and wondered how a person could be born again physically. Jesus explained that he was not talking about a natural birth, but a spiritual one. He said that no one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. The water here refers to the cleansing and renewal that God provides through his word and his grace. The Spirit here refers to the Holy Spirit, who gives new life and power to those who believe in Jesus. Being born of the Spirit means being transformed by God's presence and becoming a new creation in Christ.

This spiritual birth is related to God pouring his Spirit on all people in the last days, as prophesied by Joel and quoted by Peter in Acts 2:17. The outpouring of the Spirit is a sign of God's salvation and judgment in the end times. It is also a fulfillment of God's promise to make a new covenant with his people and write his law on their hearts (Jeremiah 31:31-34). Those who receive the Spirit are marked as God's children and heirs (Romans 8:14-17). They also become witnesses of Jesus and his resurrection (Acts 1:8). The Spirit enables them to understand God's word, to pray, to worship, to serve, and to love (1 Corinthians 2:10-16; Romans 8:26-27; Ephesians 5:18-21; Galatians 5:13-14). Therefore, being born of the Spirit is not only a requirement for entering the kingdom of God, but also a privilege and a responsibility for living in it.

'In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people.' Explain how being born of the Spirit of John 3:4-5 is related to God pouring his Spirit on all people of Acts 2:17.**# How to Be Born of the Spirit: A Reflection on John 3:4-5 and Acts 2:17**

Have you ever wondered what it means to be born of the Spirit? Jesus told Nicodemus, a Pharisee and a ruler of the Jews, that unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God (John 3:5). Nicodemus was puzzled by this statement and asked how a man can be born when he is old (John 3:4). Jesus explained that he was not talking about a physical birth, but a spiritual one. He said that the Spirit gives birth to spirit, and that whoever believes in him will have eternal life (John 3:6-16).

But what does it mean to be born of the Spirit? How can we experience this new birth? And what does it have to do with God pouring out his Spirit on all people in the last days, as prophesied by Joel and quoted by Peter on the day of Pentecost (Acts 2:17)?

To answer these questions, we need to understand the role of the Spirit in God's plan of salvation. The Spirit is the third person of the Trinity, who is co-equal and co-eternal with the Father and the Son. The Spirit is also called the Helper, the Comforter, the Advocate, the Counselor, and the Spirit of truth (John 14:16-17). The Spirit's work is to reveal Jesus to us, to convict us of our sin and our need for him, to regenerate us and make us new creatures in Christ, to indwell us and empower us for godly living and service, to guide us into all truth and teach us God's will, to intercede for us according to God's will, to produce his fruit in us, and to give us spiritual gifts for the edification of the church (John 15:26-27; John 16:7-15; Titus 3:5; 2 Corinthians 5:17; Romans 8:9-11; Galatians 5:22-23; 1 Corinthians 12:4-11; Romans 8:26-27).

Being born of the Spirit means that we have received this amazing work of the Spirit in our lives. It means that we have been cleansed from our sins by the blood of Jesus, and that we have been given a new nature and a new identity as children of God. It means that we have been transferred from the domain of darkness into the kingdom of his beloved Son (Colossians 1:13). It means that we have been sealed with the promised Holy Spirit, who is the guarantee of our inheritance until we acquire possession of it (Ephesians 1:13-14).

Being born of the Spirit also means that we are part of God's end-time plan to pour out his Spirit on all people. This plan was foretold by the prophet Joel, who said that in the last days God would pour out his Spirit on all flesh, and that sons and daughters would prophesy, young men would see visions, old men would dream dreams, and even on male and female servants God would pour out his Spirit (Joel 2:28-29). This prophecy was fulfilled on the day of Pentecost, when the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance (Acts 2:1-4). Peter explained that this was what Joel had spoken about, and that whoever calls on the name of the Lord will be saved (Acts 2:16-21).

Being born of the Spirit means that we are part of this ongoing fulfillment of Joel's prophecy. It means that we have received the same Spirit that was poured out on Pentecost, and that we can expect him to work in us and through us in various ways. It means that we can prophesy, see visions, dream dreams, speak in tongues, interpret tongues, heal the sick, cast out demons, perform miracles, and do whatever else the Spirit enables us to do for God's glory and for the benefit of others (1 Corinthians 14; Mark 16:17-18; Acts 2:43). It means that we are living in the last days, and that we are witnesses of Jesus to a lost and dying world (Acts 1:8).

Being born of the Spirit is not a one-time event, but a continuous reality. It is not something that we achieve by our own efforts, but something that we receive by God's grace. It is not something that we can boast about, but something that we can rejoice in. It is not something that we can take for granted, but something that we can cherish and cultivate.

If you have been born of the Spirit, thank God for his wonderful gift. If you have not been born of the Spirit yet or if you are not sure if you have been born of the Spirit or not, ask God to reveal himself to you through his Son Jesus Christ. Ask him to forgive your sins and to give you a new heart. Ask him to fill you with his Holy Spirit and to make you his child. Ask him to pour out his Spirit on you and to use you for his glory.

Being born of the Spirit is not only possible but necessary. It is not only desirable but essential. It is not only a privilege but a responsibility. It is not only a blessing but a challenge. It is not only a joy but a duty.

The following text is a blog post about the spiritual significance of being born again through the Kundalini awakening, based on the keywords given.

Have you ever wondered what it means to be born again? Many religions and spiritual traditions talk about the concept of rebirth, regeneration, or transformation of the self. But what does it really entail? How can we experience it in our lives?

"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born again he cannot see the kingdom of God." (John 3:3)

Nicodemus was puzzled by this answer. He asked:

"How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" (John 3:4)

Jesus clarified his meaning:

"Truly, truly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit." (John 3:5-6)

Here, Jesus is using metaphors to describe the two types of birth: physical and spiritual. The first birth is of water, which refers to the amniotic fluid that surrounds the fetus in the womb. The second birth is of Spirit, which refers to the divine breath that gives life to all living beings.

The first birth is natural and inevitable for every human being. The second birth is supernatural and optional for those who seek it. The first birth gives us a physical body and a worldly identity. The second birth gives us a spiritual body and a heavenly identity.

The first birth makes us children of our earthly parents. The second birth makes us children of God.

The first birth binds us to the cycle of birth and death. The second birth frees us from this cycle and grants us eternal life.

The first birth makes us see things as they appear. The second birth makes us see things as they are.

The first birth makes us live in fear and sin. The second birth makes us live in love and grace.

The first birth makes us depend on our own efforts and merits. The second birth makes us depend on God's grace and mercy.

The first birth makes us conform to the world. The second birth makes us transform by renewing our minds.

The first birth makes us follow our own will. The second birth makes us follow God's will.

The first birth makes us slaves of our passions and desires. The second birth makes us masters of our emotions and thoughts.

The first birth makes us separate from God and each other. The second birth makes us one with God and each other.

How can we be born again? How can we awaken our Kundalini? There are many paths and methods that claim to lead to this goal, but they all share some common elements: faith, surrender, devotion, purification, meditation, service, and love.

Faith is trusting in God's power and presence in our lives. It is believing that he loves us unconditionally and has a plan for our highest good. It is accepting his grace and forgiveness for our sins and mistakes.

Surrender is letting go of our ego and attachments. It is giving up our control and expectations. It is allowing God to work in us and through us according to his will.

Devotion is expressing our love and gratitude to God. It is worshipping him with our words and actions. It is dedicating our lives to him and his purposes.

Purification is cleansing our body, mind, and soul from all impurities and toxins. It is following a healthy lifestyle that supports our physical and mental well-being. It is practicing moral values that reflect our spiritual nature.

Meditation is focusing our attention on God or his attributes. It is quieting our thoughts and emotions and listening to his voice within. It is experiencing his peace and joy in our hearts.

Service is helping others in need without expecting anything in return. It is sharing our gifts and talents with others for their benefit. It is being compassionate and kind to all living beings.

Love is feeling God's love for us and extending it to others. It is seeing God in everyone and everything. It is being generous and forgiving with ourselves and others.

These are some of the ways that we can prepare ourselves for being born again through Kundalini awakening. However, we cannot force or manipulate this process by our own efforts or techniques. It is ultimately a gift from God that he bestows on whom he wills when he wills.

One example of someone who received this gift is Pariah Kutta (not his real name), an Indian man who claims to have had a Kundalini awakening in 1993 at the age of 42. He wrote about his experience on his blog:

"Mukhtiar Kaur gave me the first physical birth of flesh in 1951 but my Mother Kundalini gave me the second spiritual rebirth of Spirit in 1993." (June 28, 2022)

He describes how he felt a sudden surge of energy rising from his lower back to his head while he was meditating one day:

"I felt as if I was lifted up by some invisible force ... I felt as if I was floating in space ... I felt as if I was surrounded by light ... I felt as if I was filled with bliss ... I felt as if I was one with everything ... I felt as if I was born again."

He also claims that his Kundalini awakening gave him various psychic abilities such as clairvoyance, telepathy, astral projection, healing powers, etc., which he uses for helping others.

He attributes his Kundalini awakening to the grace of Shri Mataji Nirmala Devi (1923-2011), an Indian spiritual teacher who founded Sahaja Yoga (Spontaneous Union), a movement that aims to awaken people's Kundalini through self-realization techniques.

According to Shri Mataji:

"The Kundalini rises through a very thin line of Brahmanadi [the central nadi]. In the beginning, only a hair-like thing rises; it pierces through; in some people, it rises also [in] a big way ... And then it pierces this fontanel bone area [the soft spot on top of an infant's skull] which is a real baptism ... Today only people felt [the] Cool Breeze coming out of their heads ... They felt [the] Cool Breeze in [their] hands ... it's written in [the] Bible ... that it's [the] Cool Breeze; Cool Breeze [is] the sign of [the] Holy Ghost ... You start feeling [the] Cool Breeze in your hands; you start feeling [the] Cool Breeze on your head ... This [is] actualization." (1980)

Shri Mataji claims that she has given this experience to millions of people around the world through her teachings and seminars.

Whether we believe Pariah Kutta or Shri Mataji or not, their stories illustrate how some people have interpreted their Kundalini awakening as being born again through water (Cool Breeze) and Spirit (Holy Ghost).

Being born again through Kundalini awakening may not be for everyone; it may not be necessary or desirable for some people; it may not happen at all for others; it may happen differently for each individual; it may have different names and meanings across cultures; it may have different effects and consequences

on one's life; it may have different challenges and risks involved; it may have different levels and stages involved; it may have different purposes and goals involved ...

But whatever it may be for each one of us, it surely points to one thing: a deeper connection with ourselves, with others, and with God.
